Routines of holiness start with recognition of a holy God.

Leviticus 10:2-3 *So fire went out from the Lord and devoured them, and they died before the Lord. 3 And Moses said to Aaron, “This is what the Lord spoke, saying:*

‘By those who come near Me

I must be regarded as ^choly; And before all the people, I must be glorified.’”

So Aaron held his peace.

Leviticus 11:44-45 *For I am the Lord your God. You shall therefore ^cconsecrate yourselves, and you shall be ^dholy; for I am ^dholy. Neither shall you defile yourselves with any creeping thing*

that creeps on the earth. ⁴⁵For I am the Lord who brings you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God. You shall therefore be ^d**holy**, for I am ^d**holy**.

^cThis word is actually the verb ***qadash*** meaning to consecrate. We see it used the first time in Genesis 2:3 “Then God blessed the seventh day and sanctified it, because in it He rested from all His work which God had created and made.

This same word is used 175 times in the Old Testament, usually as “sanctify,” “consecrate” and sometimes “holy.”

^dThis word is the adjective ***qadosh*** meaning sacred, holy. It is used 118 times in the Old Testament:

- Of God:
 - Separated on theophanic throne
 - Separate from human infirmity, impurity and sin
 - Divine name
- Of places, persons, priests, angels, time and once of water

Although this includes 293 uses in the Old Testament, this is not exhaustive!

Routines of holiness are impossible without personal holiness.

I Corinthians 3:16-17 *Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? ¹⁷If anyone defiles the temple of God, God will destroy him. **For the temple of God is holy, which temple you are.***

Ephesians 1:3-5 *Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ, ⁴just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, **that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love,** ⁵having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will,*

I Peter 1:14-16 *as obedient children, not conforming yourselves to the former lusts, as in your ignorance; ¹⁵but as He who called you is ^eholy, you also be holy in all your conduct, ¹⁶because it is written, “Be holy, for I am holy.”*

The word “holy” is found 174 times in the NKJV of the New Testament.

^e *hágios*: set apart by (or for) God, holy, sacred; means "likeness of nature with the Lord" because "different from the world." It is used 235 times in the New Testament.

Routines of holiness recognize that the routine is holy.

God showed the Israelites how to incorporate holiness into every fiber of life. ← See back

What does this look like today?

Most of the New Testament gives us instructions on inner holiness, rather than outer appearance of holiness:

Matthew 23:26-28 *“Blind Pharisee, first cleanse the inside of the cup and dish, that the outside of them may be clean also.*

²⁷ *“Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you are like whitewashed tombs which indeed appear beautiful outwardly, but inside are full of dead men’s bones and all uncleanness.*

²⁸ *Even so you also outwardly appear righteous to men, but inside you are full of hypocrisy and lawlessness.”*

We do however; see instructions on what it looks like to pull holiness into daily lives:

Hagiázō is a verb that stems from the adjective **hágios**, and means to **to make holy, consecrate, sanctify**. We see it in Ephesians 5:21, 25-26: *25 submitting to one another in the fear of God...²⁵ Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, ²⁶that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by [in] the word, ²⁷that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish.*

Ephesians 5:21–33; 6:1–9 shows what holiness looks like in relationships

Wantonness, This is prefaced by Ephesians 5:18-20 *And do not be drunk with wine, in which is much wastefulness* ⇒ *dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit, speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord, giving thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ...*

Scottish minister Alexander MacLaren (1826-1910) on the armor of light:

“But the dress that befits the expectant of the day is not yet the robe of the feast, but it is ‘the armour’ which, **put into plain words, means just this, that there is fighting, always fighting, to be done.**

If you are ever to belong to the day, you have to equip yourselves now with armour and weapons. I do not need to dwell upon that, but I do wish to insist upon this fact, that after all that may be truly said about growth in grace, and the peaceful approximation towards perfection in the Christian character, we cannot dispense with the other element in progress, and that is fighting.

We have to struggle for every step. **Growth is not enough to define completely the process by which men become conformed to the image of the Father, and are ‘made meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light.’** Growth does express part of it, but only a part. Conflict is needed to come in, before you have the whole aspect of Christian progress before your minds. For there will always be antagonism without and traitors within... Conflict is the law, because of the enemies, and because of the conspiracy between the weakness within and the things without that appeal to it.” (Maclaren’s Expositions)
